

Early Career Researcher Travel Grant

Eligibility

Postgraduate students and post-doctoral research fellows within 10 years of gaining their PhD. Applicants must have been a member of the British Society for Neuroendocrinology (BSN) for at least 6 months. Join today: <u>www.neuroendo.org.uk/join</u>.

Activities the Fund will support

- Strictly for attendance at UK BSN meetings.
- You must be personally presenting your work at the conference.
- Awards are to support travel (not subsistence or accommodation) and receipts for these costs are required upon return.
- Applications may be made after the meeting. Contact the BSN Membership Team (<u>theteam@neuroendo.org.uk</u>)

Award value

Awards will normally be up to a maximum of £150.

How to apply

Applications must be made through the BSN membership portal. Please log-in and then navigate to Me and the BSN > Grants. For all applicants a letter is required from your supervisor/grant holder approving your application.

Non-UK BSN Members seeking funds to attend the UK BSN meeting should apply via the International Conference Travel Fund (up to £700 available).

Deadline

Please check <u>www.neuroendo.org.uk/grants</u> for the deadline as it will change every year depending on the date of the BSN annual meeting.

Awards Committee

A subgroup of the BSN Committee chaired by the Grants Committee Chair will act as the Travel Awards Committee.

Award criteria

Typically all applications will be funded where justified. Priority will be given to, in order:

- 1) Presenters.
- 2) Those without funds.

The committee reserve the right to decide on alternative funding criteria in exceptional circumstances. **Correspondence will not be entered into with regard to award decisions.**

Grants Report Form

All successful grant applicants are expected to submit a Grants Report Form no later than 6 months after the end of the grant. This will be emailed to successful applicants. Please note, future grants will not be awarded if no Grants Report Form has been received.
