### Eligibility

Postgraduate students and post-doctoral research fellows within 10 years of gaining their PhD. Applicants must have been a member of the British Society for Neuroendocrinology (BSN) for at least 6 months. Join today: [www.neuroendo.org.uk/join](http://www.neuroendo.org.uk/join).

### Activities the Fund will support

- Strictly for attendance at **UK BSN meetings**.
- You must be personally presenting your work at the conference.
- Awards are to support registration, travel and accommodation (not subsistence) and receipts for these costs are required upon return.

### Award value

Awards will normally be up to a maximum of £200 (UK BSN Members) and £450 (Non-UK BSN Members).

### How to apply

Applications must be made through the BSN membership portal. Please log-in and then navigate to Me and the BSN > Grants. For all applicants a letter is required from your supervisor/grant holder approving your application.

### Deadline

Please check [www.neuroendo.org.uk/grants](http://www.neuroendo.org.uk/grants) for the deadline as it will change every year depending on the date of the BSN annual meeting.

### Awards Committee

A subgroup of the BSN Committee chaired by the Grants Committee Chair will act as the Travel Awards Committee.

### Award criteria

Typically all applications will be funded where justified. Priority will be given to those without funds. Please note that applications without an abstract and/or supervisor letter cannot be considered.

The committee reserves the right to decide on alternative funding criteria in exceptional circumstances.

**Correspondence will not be entered into with regard to award decisions.**

### Grants Report Form

All successful grant applicants are expected to submit a Grants Report Form no later than 6 months after the end of the grant. This will be emailed to successful applicants. Please note, future grants will not be awarded if no Grants Report Form has been received.
